## RACE EXHIBIT AT THE WING LUKE MUSEUM an invitation to participate



In 2004 the Wing Luke Museum opened “Beyond Talk: Redrawing Race,” a powerful exhibit that included 20 works by a dozen artists exploring race and racism in the U.S.

In 2013 a new exhibit about race will open at The Wing. As with the original show, the exhibit will grow out of community discussions about race and racism -- this time with a focus on youth voices and intergenerational conversations. We want elders to share their stories: How did we get where we are today? What struggles and triumphs can we carry forward from the past? We want to hear young people’s experiences as well: What’s different now? What hasn’t changed? What kind of world do they want to create as they come of age? These conversations will provide direction to the Community Advisory Committee that will develop the exhibit, and inspiration to the artists who will contribute to it.
