



THE WING'S TERMS AND CONDITIONS

This website ("Website"), located at the wingluke.org and affiliated domain names, is published and maintained by Wing Luke Museum of the Asian Pacific American Experience (The Wing) in Seattle, Washington. By accessing and using the Website, and/or using the services offered on or through the Website (the "Services"), you agree to this Terms and Conditions Agreement as it may be amended from time-to-time.

1. Website Purpose. The purpose of the Website is to provide the public with general information about The Wing, including exhibition, collection, event and visitor information. The Website, all Services, and all Content (meaning all material on the Website or offered through any Services, including, without limitation, all images, text, audio, video marks, logos, software, and their selection and arrangement) are provided only for personal, educational, and non-commercial use.

2. Copyright Ownership and Restrictions. All Content is owned and controlled by The Wing and/or its affiliates and licensors, and is protected by U.S. copyright law, international copyright conventions, and other copyright laws. You agree to abide by all such laws and all restrictions displayed on the Website in conjunction with particular Content.

Copyright, certain moral rights and other proprietary rights in certain works of art, as well as photographs of these works of art, and images of people or places, displayed on this Website, may be held by individuals and/or entities other than The Wing. This includes reproductions of works of art licensed to The Wing by third parties, such as an artist or an artist's estate holding rights to these works.

You may not modify any of the materials and you may not copy, distribute, transmit, display, perform, reproduce, publish, license, create derivative works from, transfer or sell any information or materials contained on the Website. Except as authorized under the copyright laws, you are responsible for obtaining permission before reusing any copyrighted material that is available on the Website.

3. Inappropriate Use and Access.

7. Termination. The Wing may block, suspend, or terminate your use of the Website, Content, or Services at any time for any reason. 8. Changes to this Agreement. The Wing retains the right to revise this Agreement, in whole or in part, at any time. Your use of the Website or any Content or Services after any particular revision of this Agreement will constitute your acceptance of the revised Agreement.

9. Governing Law and Venue. The Website is created and controlled by The Wing in the state of Washington. This Agreement is governed by the laws of the state of Washington, without regard to its conflict of laws and principles. By using the Website, Content, or Services, you hereby consent to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue of courts in King County, Washington in all disputes arising out of or relating to your use.

10. General. This is the entire agreement between you and The Wing and supersedes any prior understandings or agreements (written or oral). If any portion of this Agreement is held to be unenforceable, that portion will be construed in accordance with applicable law to the greatest extent possible to reflect the original intentions of the parties, and the remainder of the provisions will remain in full force and effect. The Wing's failure to insist upon or enforce strict performance of any provision of these terms will not be construed as a waiver of any provision or right.

11. Digital Millennium Copyright Act (DMCA) Notice

In operating the Website, we may act as a "services provider" (as defined by DMCA) and offer services as online provider of materials and links to third party websites.
