ABOUT JAMFEST

JamFest is a non-profit monthly neighborhood summer music festival taking place in the heart of Seattle's Chinatown-International District. This festival features a variety of live music performances at four venues taking place First Thursdays June through September (June 3, July 1, August 5, September 2). The Wing Luke will serve as one of the venues as well as a check-in point and home base for the event. To visit all four venues, tickets are \$8 general (\$25 series pass) and \$5 for Wing Luke Members (\$15 series pass).

The goal of JamFest is to encourage more visitors to experience the rich culture, restaurant and business offerings of the neighborhood through exciting live entertainment and activities. As one of several initiatives, the Wing Luke is committed to contributing to the revitalization of our historic neighborhood, the Chinatown-International District.

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

We are excited for you to consider volunteering with us for this exciting new program! We are looking for enthusiastic volunteers primarily to work during the events and assist at the different venues. Roles include:

- Help set up and take down for the performances
- Sell passes for JamFest

For you to volunteer, we ask that you meet and agree to the following guidelines:

- Must be at least 18 years old
- Complete a volunteer form
- Must be able to stand for the duration of your volunteer activities
- No alcohol can be consumed during the event

- *Will I need to commit to all 4 events?*
Although it is ideal for you to volunteer at all four events, it is not required.
- *Will I be able to hear the music performers?*
Most of our venues are smaller in size so you should be able to hear the performers in some capacity.
- *What impact will my volunteering have on the neighborhood?*
