1st STOP:

Four Seas, 714 South King Street (21 and over venue)

2nd STOP:

Sun May Company, Canton Alley on King Street between 7th & 8th Avenues South

This back alley store is Chinatown's oldest gift shop



3rd STOP:

Phnom Penh Noodle House, www.phnompenhnoodles.com, 660 South King Street

Enjoy the musical stylings of the **Killerbees**, www.myspace.com/killerbeesmusic, jazz and the world beyond, and take in dinner with 15% off for JamFest ticketholders.



4th STOP:

Chinatown-ID Business Improvement Area Headquarters, www.cidbia.org, 507 South King Street

Relax under the Chinatown Gate while a local DJ spins music to groove to. Your entryway into the Chinatown-ID, get all of your questions answered about our neighborhood and our upcoming summer events.



5th STOP:

Momo, www.momoseattle.com, 600 South Jackson Street

Make sure you head over to Momo before it closes at 8pm
